Job Purpose:

To protect and save life, property and the environment by providing vehicle and equipment repair and maintenance for Essex Fire & Rescue Service (ECFRS).

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Repair and maintain all Firefighting appliances, vehicles, trailers and all associated equipment to an acceptable high standard working in all areas to ensure skills and competence are maintained.
- 2. Carry out repairs, maintenance and recovery away from the Fire Service Workshops within or outside the county as required.
- To carry out duties in compliance with the Health & Safety guidelines, wearing Working at Height equipment, PPE and ensuring your actions do not affect colleagues and visitors.
- 4. Have responsibility for the safe use of equipment and reporting defects.
- 5. Carry out diagnostic evaluation and repairs on all vehicles and equipment
- 6. Operate a counterbalance forklift on site following appropriate training.
- 7. Attend training and refresher courses to maintain the standard of competence required including vehicle driving licences, MOT and IRTEC.
- 8. When the necessary skills/experience is reached, participate in the duty call out rota for defects/repairs outside normal hours.

- 9. To comply with the policies and procedures as laid down in the Quality management system.
- 10. If required, volunteer with the Apprenticeship and work experience programme by mentoring apprentices and students.
- 11. Positively contribute to a safe work environment ensuring compliance with Health and Safety, Risk Management, Business Continuity and Safeguarding policy and procedure. Protect all personal information in adherence with the Data Protection Act 1998.
