# NATIONAL RED PLAQUE FIRE SERVICE MEMORIAL



The grand opening of The National Red Plaque Fire Service Memorial took place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May, the memorial being set in lovely grounds situated at Rettendon Common. As a bonus we were very fortunate to be blessed with beautiful warm sunshine. The National Memorial honours fire service personnel who died on duty or those who died after their period of service.

Jan Baker, Jan Caldwell and Ray Parfitt all members of the Retired Members Association Committee, myself included, took full advantage of a preliminary look around before the formalities commenced and were astounded at the professional way the memorial and grounds had been constructed and finished. The event was superbly supported by crews in fire appliances, serving and retired fire service personnel, the public and members of the Red Knights motorcycle club who were instrumental in fundraising and construction works to help create the memorial. The Fire Brigades Union, the ECFRS Essex Fire Museum and Landowners all played their part making extraordinary efforts to create and support the memorial all of which was highlighted in speeches by various dignitaries all praising their dedication, time and generosity.

The brick wall which contains plaques displaying names of fallen Fire Fighters is impressive and forms a backdrop for the statue of a firefighter which following a formal wreath laying was unveiled, thus providing a lasting and poignant reminder of a "fire fighters job". The Sutherland Pipes and drums brought a stirring musical and visual spectacle which added another dimension to the ceremony. Following completion of formalities, refreshments were provided in a marquee giving us all a chance to catch up with colleagues, friends and an opportunity to take a further look at the memorial and the museum which is contained within the adjacent new timber building.
